COMMITTEE FINDS NO FINANCIAL INACCURACIES

The Financial Committee, composed of Turner members Ellen M. Neu, Kurt Toppel and Richard Imendorf met at the offices of Turner CPA Robert Dworkin on April 15th to review financial records. A report has been issued by the committee:

We, the Financial Committee of the Los Angeles Turners, having agreed upon procedure and criteria for a thorough and accurate review of financial records hereby report the following:

- Records reviewed began at the sale of the old Turner facility of Wilshire Blvd. and continued through the closing of February 2010.
- 2. No irregularities, improprieties or errors were found.
- Some suggestions concerning bookkeeping practices were made with implementation to occur at such a time where practical and possible.

In summary, we found that from the records we have reviewed that financial accuracy has been maintained throughout the period and according to the documents examined.

After reading the report submitted by the Financial Committee we, the Board of Directors of the Los Angeles Turners wish to thank the Committee members for devoting their time, energies and abilities to this matter. In addition, we, having reviewed the recommendations received concerning bookkeeping practices agree in both content and policy and will, to the best of our ability implement as suggested or with technological betterment those suggestions and methods as soon as physical operating conditions both allow and permit.
